Every day, over 1,700 people with disability work at Endeavour Foundation.



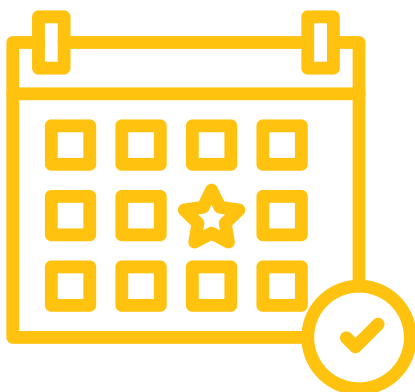
They do great work and help the Australian workforce.

Nominate means to tell us who you think should win an award.



You can nominate:

An **organisation**.

An **organisation** is a company or business that helps people with disability



A **social enterprise**

Social enterprise is a work site run by Endeavour Foundation



A **person**

Person in this context is someone who has done something great for people with disability

1. Results that shine award

This award is for a social enterprise that does great work every day.



They also help people learn new skills.



2. Advocacy in action award

Advocacy means standing up for the rights of people with disability.

This award is for a person who helps more people understand disability.



They may do this through media like TV, radio, or social media.



3. Partnership excellence award

This award is for a business that works closely with Endeavour Foundation.

They help people with disability find good jobs.



4. Charity champion award

This award is for an organisation that gives money or help to Endeavour Foundation.

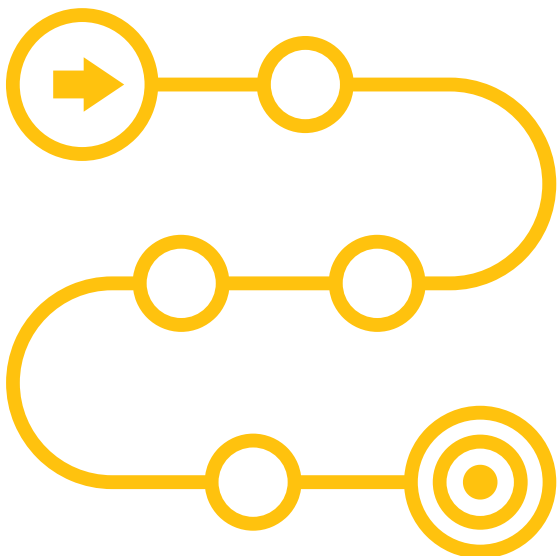
They support our goals and work.

There is a **process** to follow when you nominate someone.

A **process** is the steps you need to take.



You are called the **nominator**.

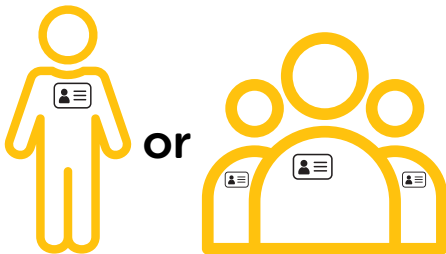


The person, social enterprise or organisation you are nominating is called the **nominee**.



You will need to fill out a **nomination form**.

A **nomination form** is a paper or online document where you write down information about the nominee.



You will need to tell us:

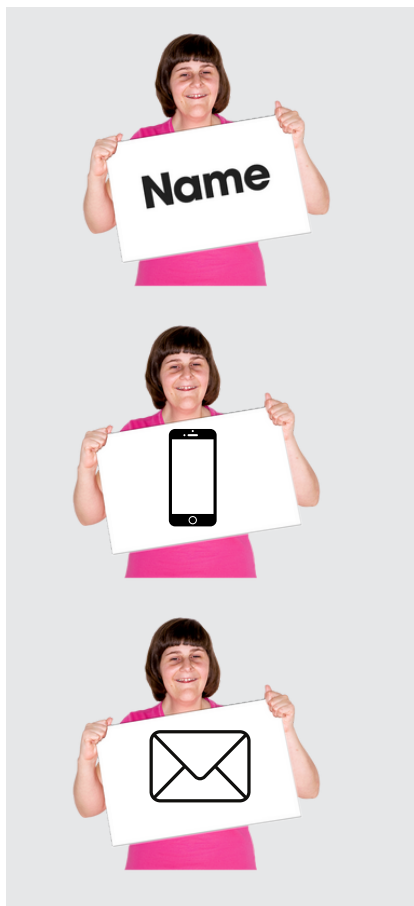
- The name of the person, social enterprise or organisation you are nominating



- Their phone number and email address



If you don't know their contact details, please ask your Site Manager or Employment Coach. They can help you.



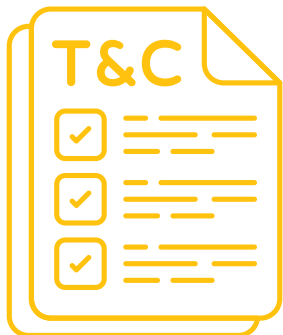
You will also need to tell us:

- Your email address



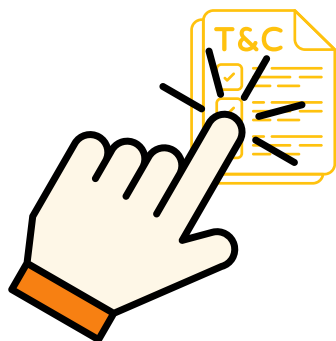
We will only use your information to help with the nomination.

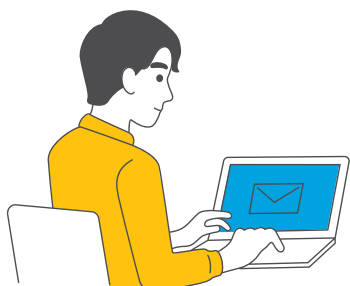
